AN OVERVIEW OF “SAC”

The School Age Care or ‘SAC’ program operation throughout the school year and follows the Cohoes City School Districts calendar. Care is offered at the Cohoes Community Center .(on days off of school) and at three satellite locations— Abram Lansing, Harmony Hill, and Van Schaick Elementary School.

Curriculum & Programming

The SAC program provides both morning and afternoon care, Morning care begins as early as 7:00AM and concludes at 8:30 AM , when children are dismissed to their teachers. Afternoon care begins at school dismissal and ends promptly at 5:30PM

The SAC program offers are by pre-registration for early dismissal, single holidays, and week long vacations at our Community Center site . No pre- registration is required for snow days.

Throughout the School year the SAC staff engage the children in a number of theme based “gym” arts& crafts, dramatic plays, nutrition, cooking, science, history, and nature activities. The program also offers unique sports & nutrition enhancement programming.



During snow days and the holiday care our program offerings are augmented with field trips to area attraction and swimming at the pool .

Our collective goal is to promote positive social interactions, to provide the children with communication and conflict mediation

skill and to serve as an ally to and resource for The families who are part of the SAC program. SAC is a child oriented program that helps prepare today’s child for tomorrow’s adult world.



Who Will Care For My Child?

The SAC program is licensed, regulated, and inspected by the office of Children and Family Services. Each staff person is subject to an extensive background check through the NYS Central Registry and fingerprinted through the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services to ensure your child will have a safe and quality environment.



The staff undergoes continuous training to maximize their interactions with your child. All staff adhere to the regulations of school age care as outlined by part 414 of the NYS Department of Social Services Law.

How To Enroll Your Child

Parent may elect to register their child for the AM only, PM only or AM& PM program. To register, parents must complete a registration packet and a fee payment agreement. Parents must also supply a current physical of their child and immunization record. Finally pre-payment of a two week security deposit, a one week advance care payment and a \$10 registration fee is required.

*Single holidays or snow day fees are in addition to the weekly parent fee.

**During week long vacation care is offered by pre-registration which is taken on a daily basis .if you do not enroll during weeks in which week long care is offered, the weekly fee is waived.

Families enrolling a second child received a 10% discount. The Cohoes Child Development Center reserves the right to raise rates with a 30 day notice to participants, income eligible families may be eligible for care assistance through NYS DSS.
